Beauty and The Beast Pantomime at Bridlington Spa Free family tickets available

As part of the Holiday Activities and Food programme (HAF), East Riding of Yorkshire Council we have limited tickets available to offer families the opportunity to enjoy free tickets for the pantomime production of Beauty and the Beast at Bridlington Spa. They can be requested by families of children and young people aged 5 - 16 years who have an Education Health and Care Plan.

Parents can apply for up to two adult tickets to accompany a child and have a memorable family experience. Siblings are also eligible to attend and should be included in the total number required in the table on the following page.

Beauty and the Beast tickets are available for the following performances:-

Wednesday 27th December 2023 – 6pm (relaxed performance) – 150 tickets available Thursday 28th December 2023 – 2pm (BSL performance) – 50 tickets available

A Christmas dinner is provided for the whole family at the pantomime. This will be served **before** each performance in the Royal Hall. For the 2pm show, food will be available from 12.00pm and for the 6pm show, food service is from 4.00pm.

Please be aware we only have 200 tickets available across the two performances and due to anticipated demand, we will be unable to contact those families who's requests we cannot fulfil. If you have not heard from us within 7 days unfortunately this time around, we have been unable to allocate you tickets. Bridlington Spa are not involved with the allocations, only the issuing of tickets so please do not contact them directly. Tickets will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and with priority given to users of BSL for the designated performance. Families must ensure they are available for either performance before applying. We will update the local offer when ticket requests will no longer be accepted.

If you have already received tickets from the as part of the benefits related free school meal allocation you will be unable to apply for further tickets.
