

Summer Holidays Support and Activities

We are aware that the summer holiday period can be a relief and welcome break for some families and a difficult time for others, so we have compiled a list of Council Teams and their contact details along with those services who are only accessible in term time.

There is a lot going on in the area this summer for children, young people and families so we have also included information about the activities that are taking place during the holidays and booking links to access them.

Safeguarding and Partnership Hub (SaPH)

If you are a young person, family member, carer, or member of the public and you want to discuss a child that you are worried about, or make a self-referral you can contact the Safeguarding and Partnership Hub (SaPH) during office hours on (01482) 395500 - Choose 'Option 1' and a social worker will be able to talk through your worries with you and discuss what happens next.

No changes to the working hours for the service Monday to Thursday 8:30am - 5pm and Friday 8:30am - 4.30pm

Children's Emergency Duty Team (Out of hours)

If you have a worry about a child outside of office hours, the Children's Emergency duty Team (CEDT) operates to respond to emergency situations from 5pm until 8:30am Monday to Thursday and 4.30pm until 8:30am on a Friday and at weekends and bank holidays.

CEDT responds to emergency situations that are unable to wait until the next working day.

Early Help and Prevention Team

Free School Meals Information

We are funding free school meals vouchers for all eligible children for the Summer holidays. If your child attends an East Riding school, then your school will arrange this for you.

Meetings in Settings for Parents and Carers
